Peripatetic Instrumental Lessons



Students at TBHA have the opportunity to learn an instrument. If you are interested in having lessons in any instrument, please see Mrs Freen and she will give you all the details you need to know: You can choose from the list below:

- Drums
- Piano
- Singing
- Guitar
- Bass
- Strings (Violin, Viola, Cello or Double Bass)
- Woodwind (Saxophone, Oboe, Clarinet, Flute, Bassoon)
- Brass (Trumpet, Cornet, Baritone, Tuba, French Horn, Trombone)

If you would like to learn an instrument that isn't on the list please see Mrs Freen and she will try to find a teacher for you.

These lessons cost money as we hire out specialist music teachers to come to school and teach here. You may know some of our resident instrumental teachers as they visit local primary schools. If you decide to continue with music lessons, your instrumental tuition will be during lesson times. Different lessons have different costs but you will be given all the paperwork you need. The Music Department also provides a scholarship scheme, which reduces the price of some lessons to under £4! You are able to hire an instrument from us if you do not have one.
